# Section 1: Survival Begins (Pages 1-67) <u>Discussion Questions:</u>

- What do you think it would feel like to crash-land in the rainforest?
- How do Fred, Con, Lila, and Max react differently to the situation?
- What survival skills do they already have? What do they need to learn?

**Creative Challenge:** - Design a mini survival guide with 5 key jungle survival tips.

#### Section 2: Who's Who? (Pages 68-134) <u>Discussion Questions:</u>



Which character do you relate to the most? Why?
How do the characters personalities shape the way they react to danger?
How do they learn to trust each other as the story progresses?



**Creative Challenge:** - Create a character map for one of the children, showing their strengths and weaknesses

## Section 3: Message in a Leaf (Pages 135-201) <u>Discussion Questions:</u>

- If you found a hidden message in the jungle, what do you think it would say?


- How do clues from the past help the children survive?

- What does the rainforest setting add to the mood of the story?



**Creative Challenge:** - Write a hidden message on a leaf-shaped paper giving advice to another explorer.





#### Section 4: Meeting the Explorer (Pages 202-268) <u>Discussion Questions:</u>



How would you feel meeting someone who has lived alone in the jungle for years? Why do you think the explorer chose this life? What do we learn from the way the children react to him?



<u>**Creative Challenge:**</u> Write 3 questions you would ask the explorer, then answer them as if you were him.

#### Section 5: Escape or Stay? (Pages 269-335) <u>Discussion Questions:</u>

-If you were one of the children, would you stay in the jungle or try to leave?

-What skills have they gained that might help them survive longer?

-How has the adventure changed each of them?



<u>Creative Challenge:</u> - Write a persuasive letter arguing for or against staying in the jungle.

## Section 6: Reflection & Creative Responses (Pages 336-402) <u>Discussion Questions:</u>

-Was the ending satisfying? Why or why not? -What would you do differently if you were in their situation? -If the story continued, what do you think would happen next?

Creative Challenge: - Design an alternate book cover for The Explorer! What elements would you include?
